


<p>1. <u>What is a bookmark and why are they useful?</u></p> <p>The internet allows you to save shortcuts to your favourite webpages and navigate to them in seconds from any webpage.</p> <p>These can be found in a bookmarks bar along the top of your webpage.</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. search engine – a program that searches for items in a database that link to keywords specified by the user. 2. communication – exchanging of information by speaking, writing or other mediums. 3. bookmark – a shortcut saved to specific webpage. 4. digital footprint – a trail of data you create while using the internet. It includes the websites you visit, emails you send and information you submit online.
<p>2. <u>What is a digital footprint?</u></p> <p>Everyone leaves a digital footprint behind when they have been using the internet. Whenever you go online your computer is given a special number to identify it. This can be tracked to see what websites you have been visiting.</p> 	 <p>emails</p>
