



**Prior Learning:** Recognising cyber bullying online, understanding the importance of passwords and keeping personal information private, recognising safe emails and ‘phishing’ emails.

<p><b>Cyberbullying</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cyberbullying is when a child is tormented, threatened, harassed, humiliated, embarrassed or targeted by another child using the internet, interactive and digital technologies or mobile phones.</li> </ul>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Filter content – content filtering is the use of a program to screen and exclude from access or availability Web pages or e-mail that is deemed objectionable.</li> <li>2. Copyright – a law that gives the owner of a work (like a book, movie, picture, song or website) the right to say how other people can use it.</li> <li>3. Virus– a computer virus is a malicious software program loaded onto a computer without the user knowing. These can “infect” other programs on your computer.</li> <li>4. Spyware– software that can collect your private data without you knowing.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Search Engines</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A <b>search engine</b> is a web-based tool that enables users to locate information on the World Wide Web.</li> <li>These are programs that search an index of the world wide web for keywords and display the results in order.</li> <li>Search engines are a great way to find things on the web. If you search carefully you can find reliable and trustworthy information.</li> <li>Keywords are important when you search.</li> <li>If you use too few keywords you could get too many results and they won’t all be relevant.
