<p>1. <u>What is a podcast?</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A podcast is downloadable broadcast or program, which can include video, music or speech. It is in digital form and is playable on a computer device like a phone or tablet. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Import—to bring a file from one document into another document you are using. 2. Software—the programs and other operating information used by a computer. 3. Record—convert sound into a broadcast. 4. Combine - join or merge to form a single unit. 5. Quality—the standard of something as measured against other things of a similar kind.
<p>2. <u>What makes a good podcast?</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Keep it short, if it is too long it may lose listeners' attention. 2. Make it interesting. Choose your topic carefully. 3. Always speak clearly and confidently. 4. Include an appropriate introduction. 5.
