We wish to offer our Congratulations to Mrs Clarke. She has been appointed Deputy Headteacher, at a school much closer to her home.

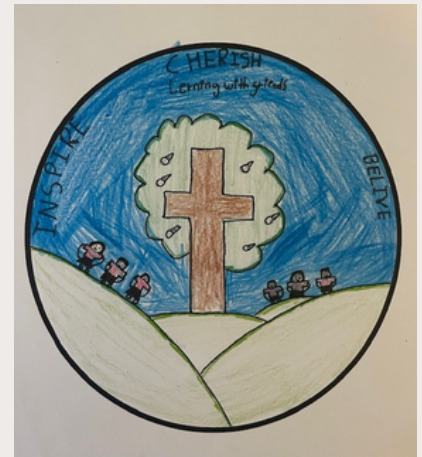
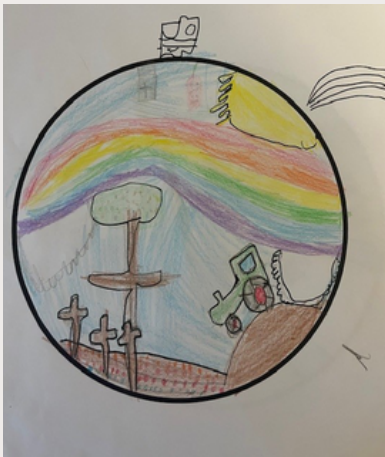
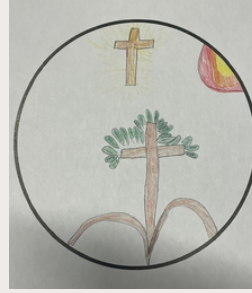
It absolutely goes with saying that Mrs Clarke will be missed enormously by every at Barnham!
