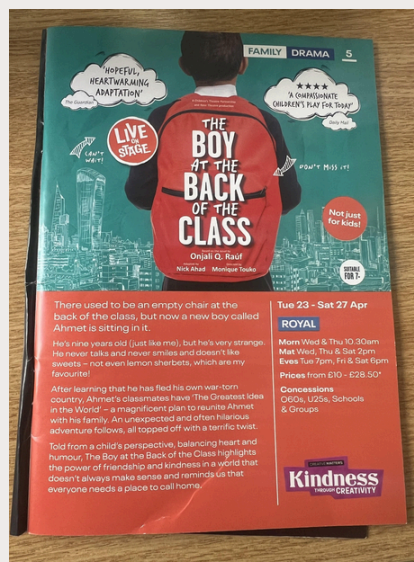
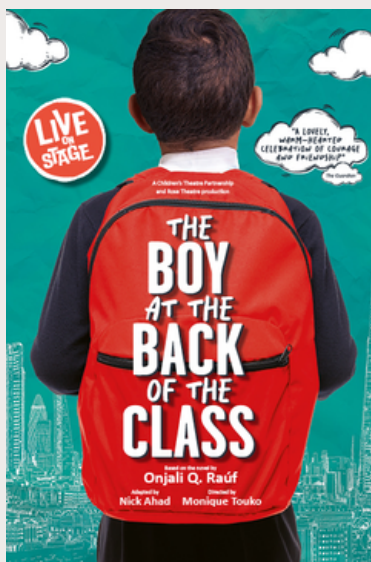

Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves.

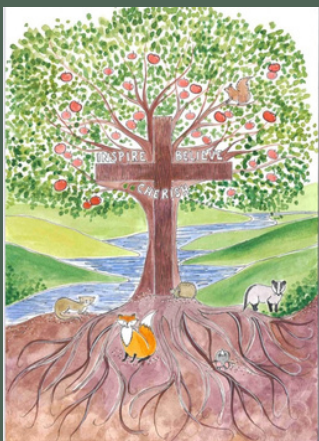
