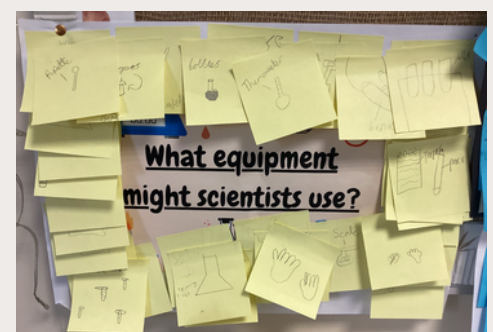
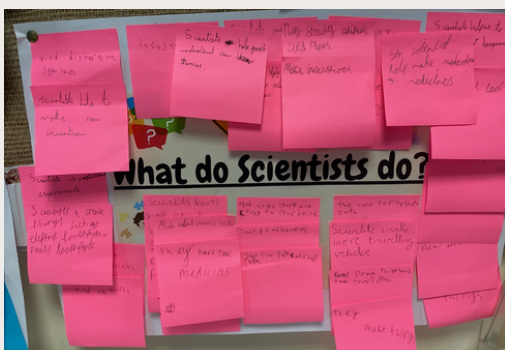
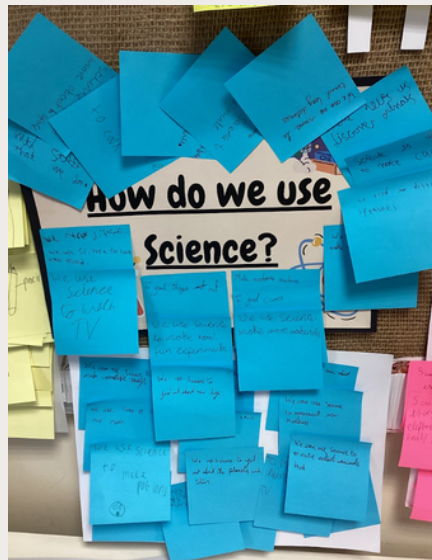
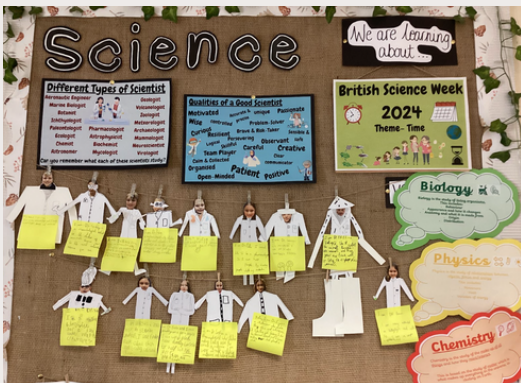
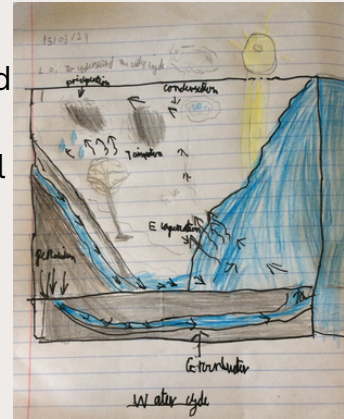
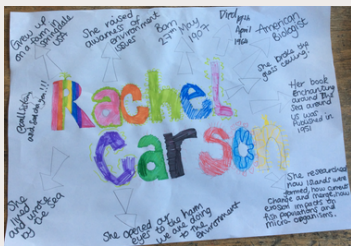
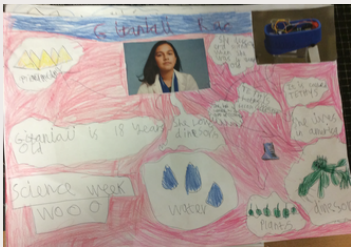
British Science Week 2024

News from Moles

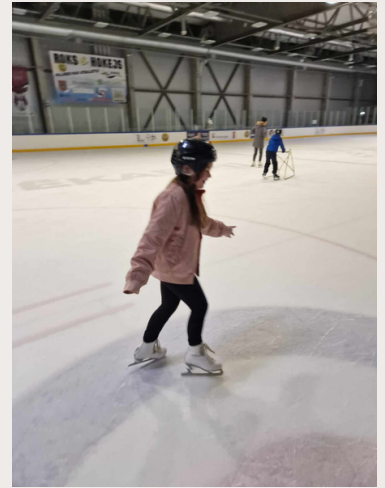
This week is Science week. Moles have learnt about the scientist Tu Youyou who discovered medicine to treat malaria. She was the first Chinese woman to win a Nobel prize.

The children enjoyed watching the science live lesson about invertebrates and learnt that butterflies can taste using their feet.

Moles then became scientists conducting their own experiment with Skittles. They had fun watching the water draw the sugar and dye from the sweets to the middle of the plate creating a rainbow effect. Cold and warm water was used for the experiment and they concluded that both worked well but at different speeds. Moles then observed the experiment again using water which contained sugar.

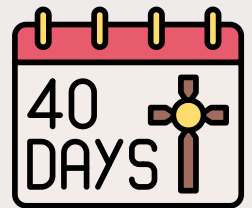

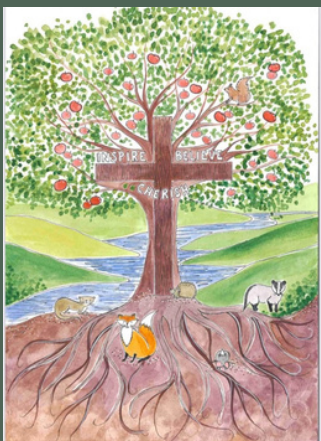
