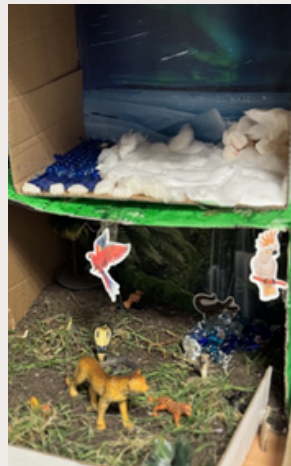

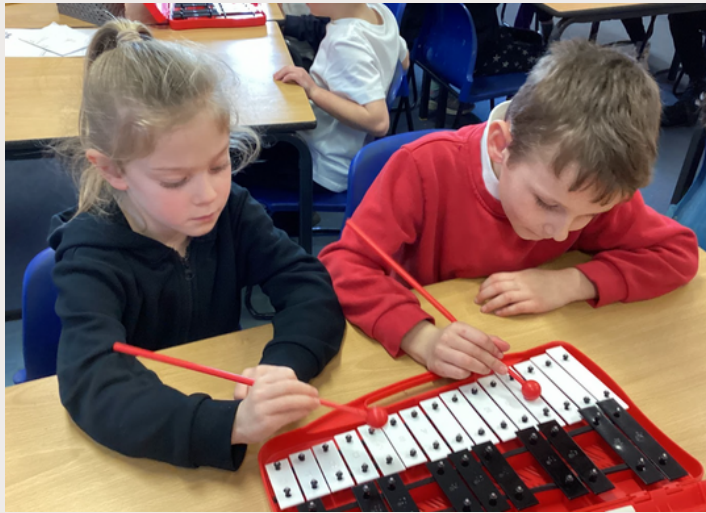
# Biomes Exhibition

Together, we can smash this!

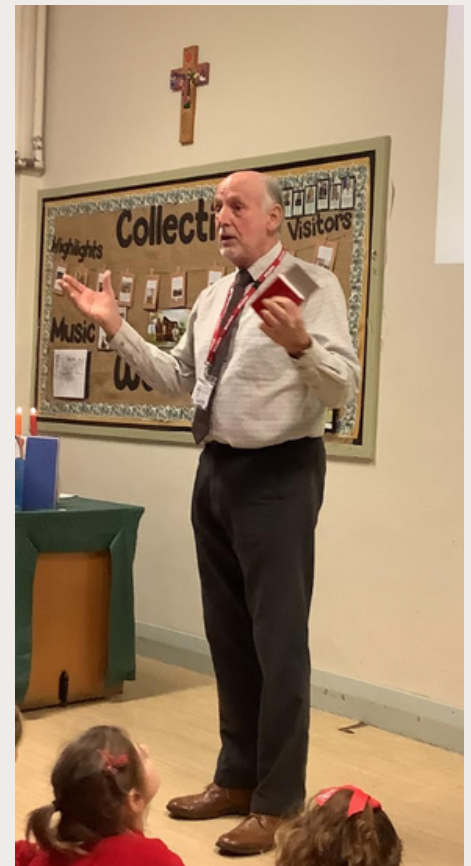
## Our Value is Truth

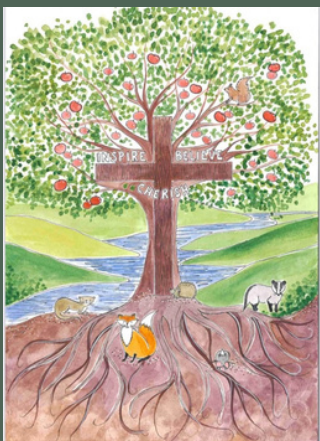
