Make sure sun cream is applied before school. If your child brings in sun cream to school then we will encourage them to apply this themselves – no spray cans of sun cream.

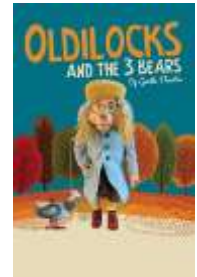
## Goldilocks
