Learning alongside the British Museum

On Wednesday Badger and Fox Class visited an archaeological dig that was being carried out by the British Museum. This knowledge engagement visit built on children's learning of both The Stone Age and Rocks and Soils. Rob from the British Museum shared how the dig works and how finds are recorded, cleaned and stored.

It was fascinating to see the archaeologists at work, slowly and carefully unearthing flints and bones which give an amazing insight into life 400,000 years ago.

Discovering a site of fire, evident through the changes in the soils colour and 'crazing' on the flints, evidences that there were Neanderthals there. Our rich discussions focussed on the ways a fire would have been used 400,000 years ago – just think we still gather around a fire at the same site ourselves during our forest school sessions!
