SPACE DAY!

Squirrels and Moles had an exciting day exploring space! It was out of this world!!

Both Squirrels and Moles have been learning all about space, so they came together to collaborate on some space projects to share and celebrate their learning. After getting to know each other, their first task was to create a model solar system. They needed to use their knowledge of the planets to ensure they were accurate about the order of the planets, they were relative to size in comparison to each other and they were the correct colours. Good communication and team work was needed in order to carefully select materials and other resources. After break, they all sampled some rock cakes made by Squirrels (which were more delicious than they sound), while looking at the double page spreads that Squirrels had created about what they had learnt.
