Suffolk Show School's Garden Competition

Year 5 children embraced the challenge of designing and creating a garden based on the theme 'A garden for all seasons' for this year's Suffolk Show School Garden Competition. They worked hard to design, research, plan and construct the garden, which of course featured a union jack design - acknowledging the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. Lucy and Joshua worked hard to saw the wood and dig out the footings for the union jack design, whilst also supporting with planting up the garden!

The garden represented each season with carefully chosen ground coverings, plants and child made accessories. The garden linked to children's prior learning with the tilt of the axis of the earth in relation to the sun, displayed in the summer and winter sections.

Judging took place on Day one of the two-day show with the children explaining the design and construction of their garden to the judges. We were just delighted to receive a 'Gold' for our garden.

Children took turns staffing the garden over the two show days and were incredible at confidently and enthusiastically talking to visitors about the garden design and build process, along with answering a myriad of questions and sharing booklet showing each phase of the project!

Calpol, Ibuprofen and Piriton
