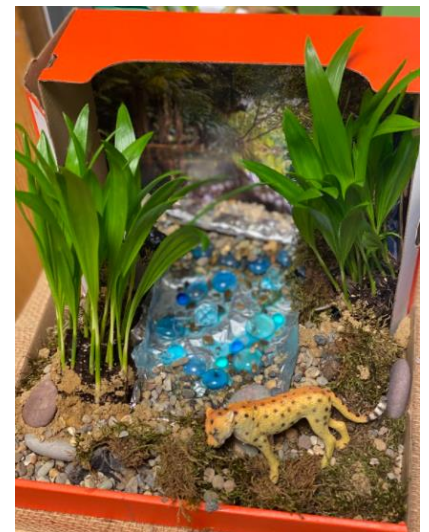
## YEAR 5 BIOMES
