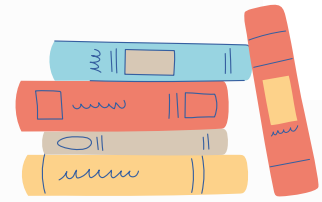
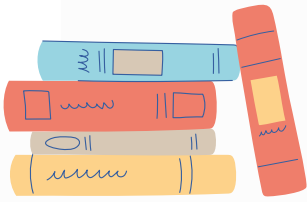

CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS READING!

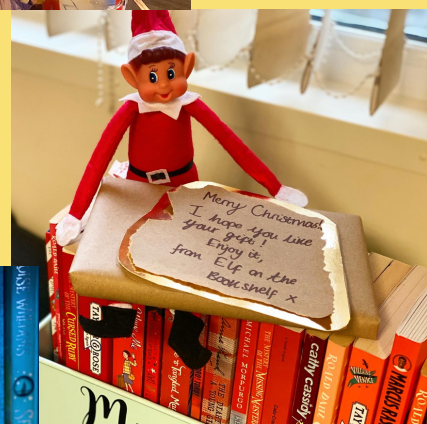
