OUR FIRST FULL WEEK BACK

We have completed our first full week at Barnham this year, and what a week it has been! The children have all settled into their learning well with their new class teachers and TAs and smiles and laughter has permeated the school 😊 Here is a little update from each class:

Hedgehogs – The children have learnt to work together, demonstrated great listening, experimented with new ways of learning, played with new friends, used the big toilets and had dinner in the school hall! It's so exciting to think that this is just the beginning of their educational adventure!

Moles – Moles went outside and explored micro-habitats, observing and discovering the places that insects like to live. They drew half and half self-portraits; one half was their own face and the other half was pictures of their favourite things.

Badgers – We have had such a wonderful start to our time in Badger Class! We are starting to learn about the Stone Age in History and in English we are learning about a stone age family in a book called UG. In Maths this week, we have been recapping and building on our knowledge about place value, ready to add and subtract numbers up to 1000! Badger team has settled really well and the children have all come in eager and ready to learn! I can't wait for the term ahead!

Foxes – In Fox Class we sketched and painted the wildflowers in our amazing bee and butterfly garden. We have started learning about the Stone Age and reading the book 'Ug: Boy Genius of the Stone Age.' We have had great fun reading and writing and performing play-scripts. We have been working on place value in maths.

Squirrels – Squirrels have been starting their new topic all about World War One. They have been thinking about what they already know about the War and what they would like to learn about it this term. They have also been reading the first few chapters of War Horse by Michael Morpurgo in English!

Otters – This week Otters have enjoyed started their new class text – War Horse by Michael Morpurgo. In Maths they have been working with numbers up to 10,000,000. We have had a great start to the new school year.

The children have all continued to join in Collective Worship together outside as the weather has been so beautiful.

This Tuesday on Channel 5pm at 9pm Ben Fogle's programme New Lives in the Wild will be featuring a familiar face to many at Barnham Primary – Will Lord.
