COVID-19 over the holiday period

What to do if your child tests positive after the end of term:

We are following the advice of Public Health England with regard to contact tracing. When a member of our community tests positive for COVID-19 we are required to notify their close contacts for the previous 48 hours, following onset of symptoms.

If your child tests positive for COVID-19 between the end of school today (18th December) and midnight on Christmas Eve, we may need to inform other pupils and staff.
