Curriculum Update: Relationships and Sex Education (RSE)

As you may already be aware, the Department for Education has announced changes to relationships and sex education following a nationwide consultation. These changes will come into effect from September 2020 and all schools will be required to comply with the updated requirements. The statutory guidance can be found at:

Consequently, from September 2020, Relationships and Sex Education (RSE), along with Health Education will be statutory and form part of the National Curriculum.
