BADGERS WOODLAND ADVENTURE

This term Badgers have been reading the book 'Into the Forest', By Anthony Browne. On Thursday, we were able to go 'Into the Forest! Mr Hawthorne took us on a tractor and trailer to Fakenham Big Wood, where we learnt about the different types of soil in a sugar beet field. We learnt that there are 3 layers - organic matter on the top, the next layer down is called top soil and even further down is sub soil. Mr Hawthorne said this was the toughest to dig because it has lots of bumpy stones in it. We compared this to the soil in the forest and discovered that the layers are the same (although it looks a lot darker). We looked at the scratches on the trees and found out that they caused from animals, such as deer, squirrels and hares. We found out that the trees have to be planted in straight lines to make it easier for them to be harvested. We adventured into a part of the woodland that was protected behind a gate; the fence and gate keep the animals out to reduce the animal damage -it was beautiful and very peaceful. Finally, we wandered to the fire and finished our morning sharing our learning and asking questions together, around the fire. We brought all of our new knowledge back to the classroom where we used our mental maths to work out how big the forest would be in a decade, our knowledge of plants in science and we were able to describe the forest in English. We had a wonderful day and learned so much 😊
