HEDGEHOG START AND FINISH TIMES

We are now a couple of weeks into term and we have been closely reviewing our staggered start and finish times. As of Monday 21st September 2020, we would like **Hedgehog Class** to come into school at **8:50am** and be picked up at **3:15pm**. Hedgehog Class will be using their own door to enter and exit their classroom, therefore, will not come into contact with any other children in the school during these times.

If you have a child who needs picking up from the school field (Squirrels and Otters) then please can you collect your youngest child from the playground and we will bring your child from Squirrels or Otters to you – stay on the playground. It is really important that you are on time for drop-off and pick-up as we do not, currently, have any provision to supervise your children as this would involve crossing bubbles.

FACE MASKS

Parents **MUST** wear a face mask when talking with a member of staff. All staff members will be wearing visors when on the playground or field. If you do not have a face mask and need to talk with a teacher then call the school office to arrange another time or a phone call home. We must all work together to keep children, parents and staff safe. Thank you.

BIRTHDAY BOOKS

We are so happy to be back to school and seeing everyone's smiling faces. Although there are some changes at school, we would still love to celebrate your child's birthday! If your child would like to celebrate their day at school, instead of sending sweets to give to the children (and to prevent any unnecessary cross-contamination) you can donate a ***Birthday Book*** to their classroom.

How it Works:

- 1) Choose a book that your child would like to donate to the class in honour of their birthday!
- 2) Inside the book, include your child's name and the date.
- 3) Send the book to school on (or near) their birthday!
- 4) We will read the book aloud to celebrate your child and then it will be placed in our library for everyone to enjoy!

INDIVIDUAL SCHOOL PHOTOS
