CORONAVIRUS

With regards to the current Coronavirus/COVID-19 situation, I would like to reassure you that we are diligently following the advice issued by the Department of Health and Social Care and Public Health England.

Good personal hygiene is the most effective way to tackle Coronavirus/COVID-19. Please help us to encourage your children to adopt excellent hygiene habits. Specifically:

- *wash their hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds (or whilst singing Happy Birthday twice)*
- *use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available*
- *cover their mouth and nose with a tissue or a sleeve (not their hands) when they cough or sneeze*
- *put used tissues in the bin straight away and wash their hands afterwards*
- *do not touch their eyes, nose or mouth if their hands are not clean*
